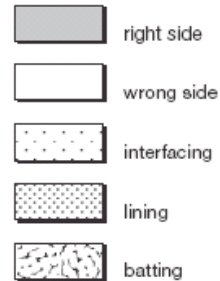
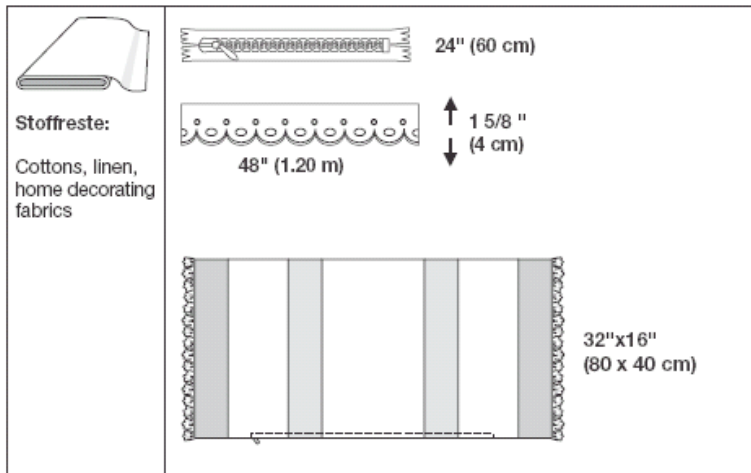
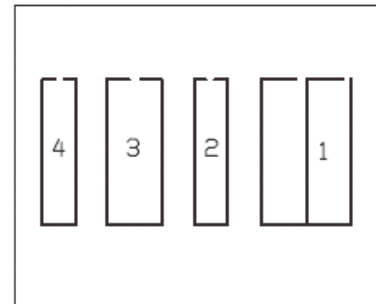

Patternpieces:



<p>PATTERN</p> <p>1 center piece 1x</p> <p>2 Side placket no. I 2x</p> <p>3 Side placket no. II 2x</p> <p>4 Side placket no. III 2x</p> <p>Paper cut for ANSI A (German DIN A4) prints: The patterns are printed out on 8 sheets with a thin frame. Wait, until all sheets are printed out. Arrange the sheets so that they fit together (see extra page with the overview of the prints). Cut off the single sheets on the upper and right edge along the thin frame lines. Begin with the left lower sheet and then glue the parts in the frame lines together precisely.</p>	<p>Cut out the pattern</p> <p>CUTTING OUT</p> <p>ALLOWANCES are included on an average: “5/8” (1.5 cm) for all edges and stitches. Cut the pattern out using fabric remnants. Let the drawings guide you, and choose and match the fabrics according to your own taste.</p> <p>MARKING</p> <p>The dotted lines on the pattern show, where the pattern pieces have to be sewn together. Mark the important lines and signs on the pattern, using BURDA carbon paper to transfer all pattern lines and markings to the left side of the fabric pieces, or you can also use chalk. You will find instructions in the packet.</p>
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
