



Move On Learning chunks

Introduction

File 2: Teaching and Learning of *Move On with a National Qualification* (the updated National Test Toolkit) includes Part 1: The Move On approach, which supports teachers to deliver the Move On approach. This includes sample session plans that outline how the two strands of delivery can effectively be combined to ensure that the needs of individual learners are being supported.

The Move On Learning chunks take this one step further. They provide a model of how teachers can support development of individual elements of the core curriculum.

The curriculum references covered are:

- **Wt/L1.2** - judge how much to write and the level of detail to include
- **Wt/L1.5** - use format and structure for different purposes
- **Rt/L2.2** - identify the purpose of a text and infer meaning which is not explicit
- **MSS1/L1.2** - reading, measuring and recording time in common date formats and using the 12 hour and 24 hour clock
- **MSS1/L2.6** - calculate with units of measure between systems, using conversion tables and scales, and approximate conversion factors.

Using examples of free *Skills For Life* resources that are currently available (including the embedded materials) and linking to realia websites, a group activity introduces the skill to be developed and provides key teaching strategies and activities

This is followed by examples of small group/individual learning activities covering a variety of levels and contexts to enable extension work and/or further consolidation of the skill as necessary.

The final section of the Move On Learning chunks gives references to specific questions from the practice tests CD-ROM to enable learners to test themselves on the skill learnt.

Move On Learning chunks could be used to support delivery of key aspects of the core curriculum as they stand. They could also form the basis of a staff development session to encourage staff to share best practice on teaching strategies and resources they currently use.
